

Making a gift to St Peter's Project

Legacies

St Peter's Project depends completely on donations, so the gifts people leave SPP in their Wills are vital and legacies provide important support for SPP. When you gift SPP you're giving to people who work to the highest level of commitment and accountability. SPP ensures funds will be used to support the purposes of the charity in the best possible way.

In order to properly draft your Will, SPP recommends to take the advice of a regulated and insured professional Solicitor.

Accordingly, if you wish to remember SPP in your Will, you can leave a fixed sum of money (*pecuniary bequest*) or a gift in your Will of what is left of your estate after all your bequests have been provided and the cost of winding up your personal affairs has been met (*residuary bequest*).

SPP suggests to use the following wording:

"I bequeath to St Peter's Project (St. Peters Italian Catholic Church, Parish Office, 4 Back Hill London EC1R 5EN, Registered Charity Number 1085823), the sum of £..... and/or x proportion of my residuary estate; and I declare that the receipt of the Trustees (for the time being) shall be a good discharge to my Executors."
